Assignments: October 17 – November 10, 2011

Daily requirements, starting Friday, Aug. 26 and thereafter for a daily participation grade:

- Arrive with your own Bible. I will discuss which Bible editions are appropriate for use in this class. Students will be expected to mark and annotate their Bibles in class as part of the instruction.
